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EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The Fall 2013 headcount increased 1.5% and the FTE increased 3.4% compared to Fall 2012. Full-time headcount was up 9 students and part-time headcount was up 20 students resulting in a total increase of 29 students. The number of students who attended EWC for the first time in Fall 2013 was up 3 full-time students and up 9 part-time students. The number of students who had attended EWC anytime prior to Fall 2013 was up 6 full-time students and up 11 part-time students. Goshen County was up 42 full-time and up 4 part-time students, and Outreach decreased by 33 full-time and increased by 16 part-time students. Goshen County FTE increased by 73.25 FTE, and Outreach decreased by 28.05 FTE. Outreach accounted for 41.9% of the FTE.

Credit course offerings are provided as regular courses in both Goshen County and the 12 outreach sites. In addition, concurrent enrollment in the high schools, and distance learning courses are also offered. Outreach had 66.0% of its 578.37 FTE from concurrent enrollment courses. Goshen County courses generated 802.08 FTE of which 9.2% were from concurrent enrollment courses, 6.3% from evening courses, and 19.6% from distance education courses.

One of the challenges in scheduling courses is determining the time and delivery method that will best serve the largest number of students and accommodate the needs of non-traditional and site bound students. Some of the on-campus day students do enroll in distance learning and/or evening courses. The 119 distance education courses served 215 students living in EWC's outreach areas and 191 students living in Goshen County for a total of 406 students. However, 135 (70.7%) of the 191 students in Goshen County were also enrolled in regular on-campus day courses. Similarly, the 22 on-campus credit evening courses served a total of 219 students with 189 (86.3%) of the students also enrolled in regular on-campus day courses.

Developmental courses are offered for those students who do not have college level skills in reading, writing, and mathematics. Developmental courses enrolled 272 students which accounted for 7.56% of the FTE. Of the 272 students enrolled in developmental courses, 195 (71.7%) of those students are seeking an associate degree or certificate.

The total Fall 2013 headcount was 1,963 students. Of those students, 1,218 (62.0%) were non-degree seeking. The programs with the largest enrollments were Interdisciplinary Studies, Welding & Joining Technology, Veterinary Technology, Education Cluster, and Agriculture Cluster. Eastern Wyoming College provides numerous non-credit and workforce development offerings. EWC's non-credit enrollment was 1,588 students compared to 1,641 students in Fall 2012.

The Fall 2013 on-campus, full-time students came from 19 states and two foreign countries. Most of the students came from five states: Wyoming, Nebraska, Colorado, South Dakota, and Montana. Within Wyoming, the full-time, on-campus students came from 21 counties, with the majority coming from Goshen, Laramie, and Platte. The gender distribution for all credit students reflects 43% male and 57% female. The ethnicity distribution was 89% white non-Hispanic, 7% Hispanic, and 4% all others. The average age of students enrolled in credit courses was 25.89 with a 21.94 average for full-time students and a 28.01 average for part-time students.

FALL 2013 ENROLLMENT SUMMARY

EWC experienced an increase of 1.5% in total student headcount as compared to Fall 2012. The total student headcount of 1,963 students reflects an overall increase of 29 students. Total full-time enrollment is 27 students above the five-year average and total part-time enrollment is 66 students above the five-year average for a total of 93 students above the five-year average.

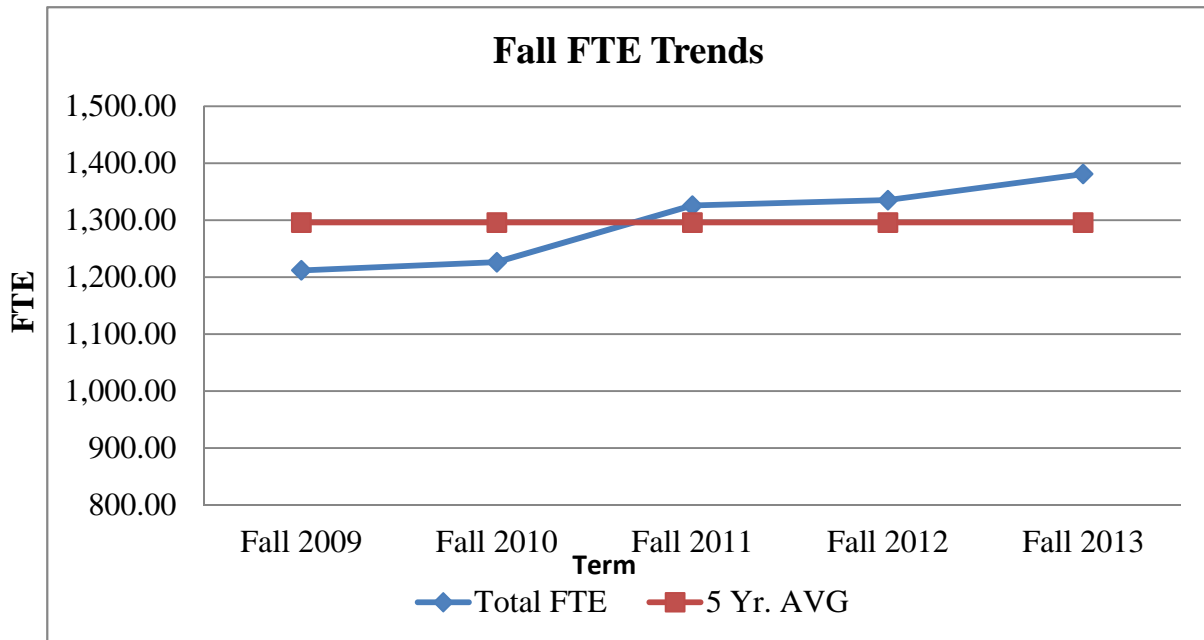
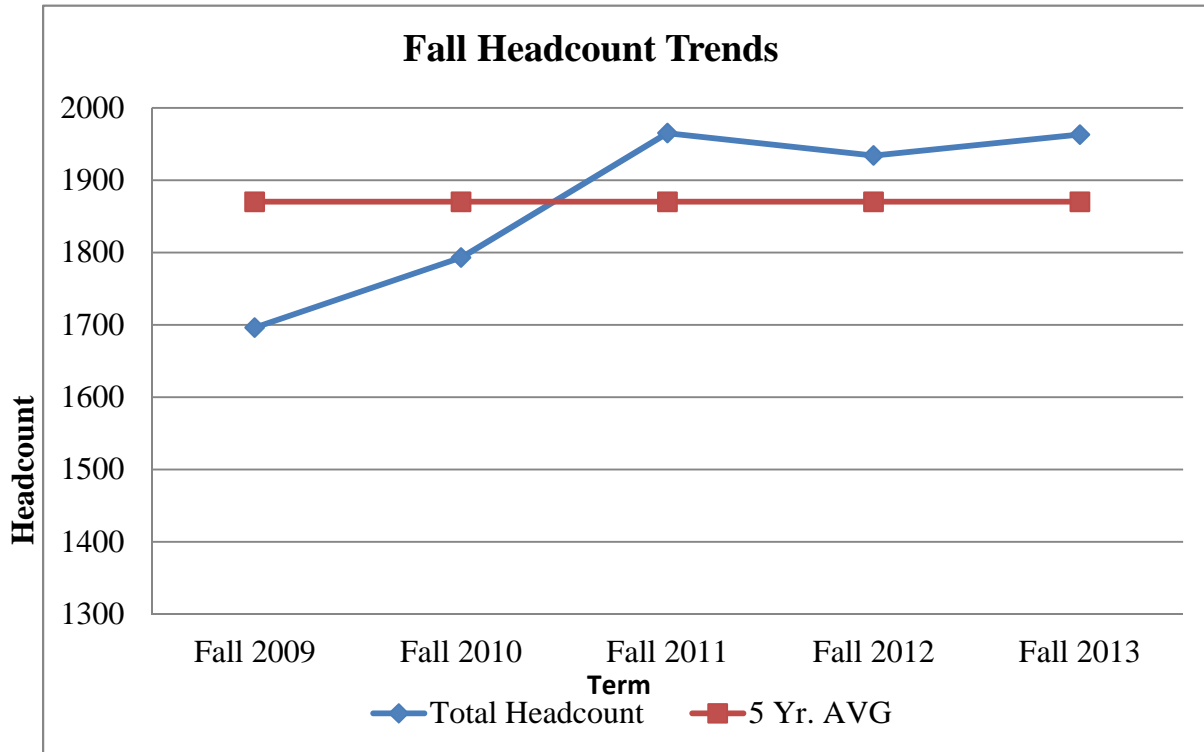

Fall Trends



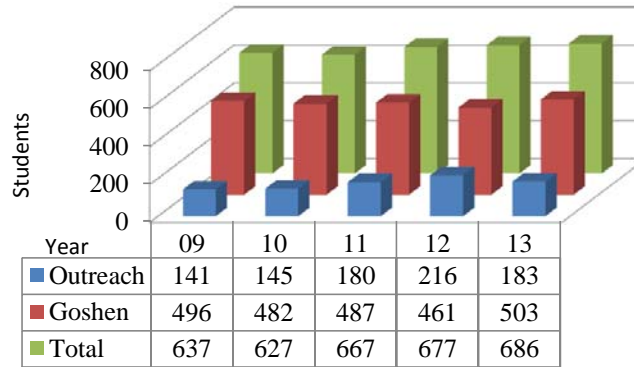
FALL FULL-TIME HEADCOUNT

EWC experienced a decrease of 33 (15.3%) full-time students in Outreach enrollment and an increase of 42 (9.1%) students in Goshen County for a total increase of 9 (1.3%) students as compared to Fall 2012. Outreach full-time headcount was 10 above the five-year average. Goshen County was 17 above the five-year average. Total headcount of 686 full-time students was 27 students above the five-year average.

FALL PART-TIME HEADCOUNT

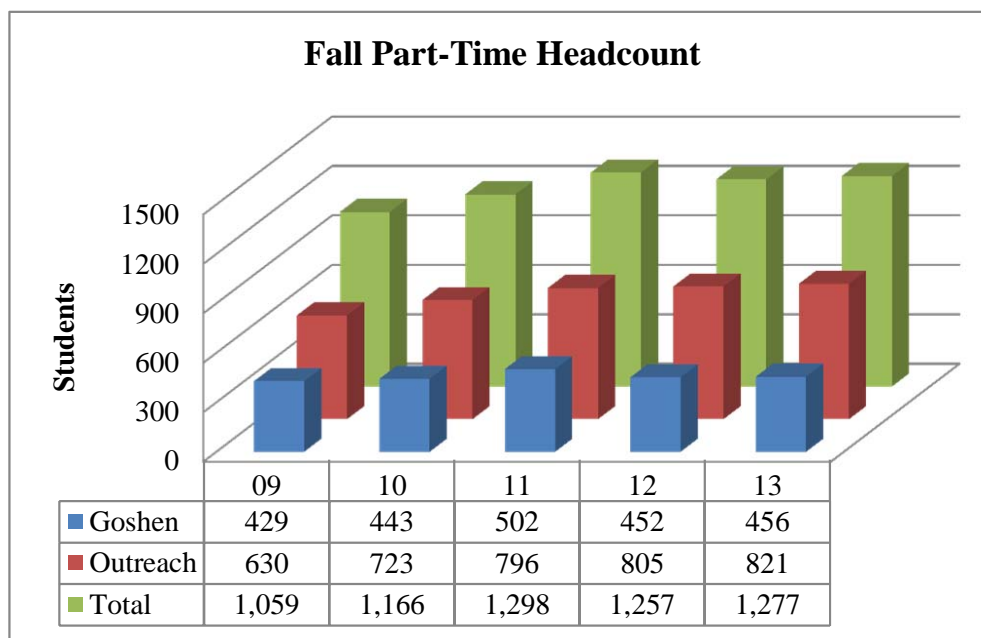
EWC experienced an increase of 16 (2.0%) part-time students in outreach enrollment and an increase of 4 (0.9%) students in Goshen County for a total increase of 20 (1.6%) students as compared to Fall 2012. Fall 2013 Outreach part-time headcount was 66 students above the five-year average, and Goshen County part-time headcount was equal with the five-year average. The total part-time headcount was above the five-year average by 66 students.

The most significant changes were an increase of 119 (32 full-time and 87 part-time) students in the 17-24 age group and a decrease of 36 (21 full-time and 15 part-time) students in the 16 or younger age group.

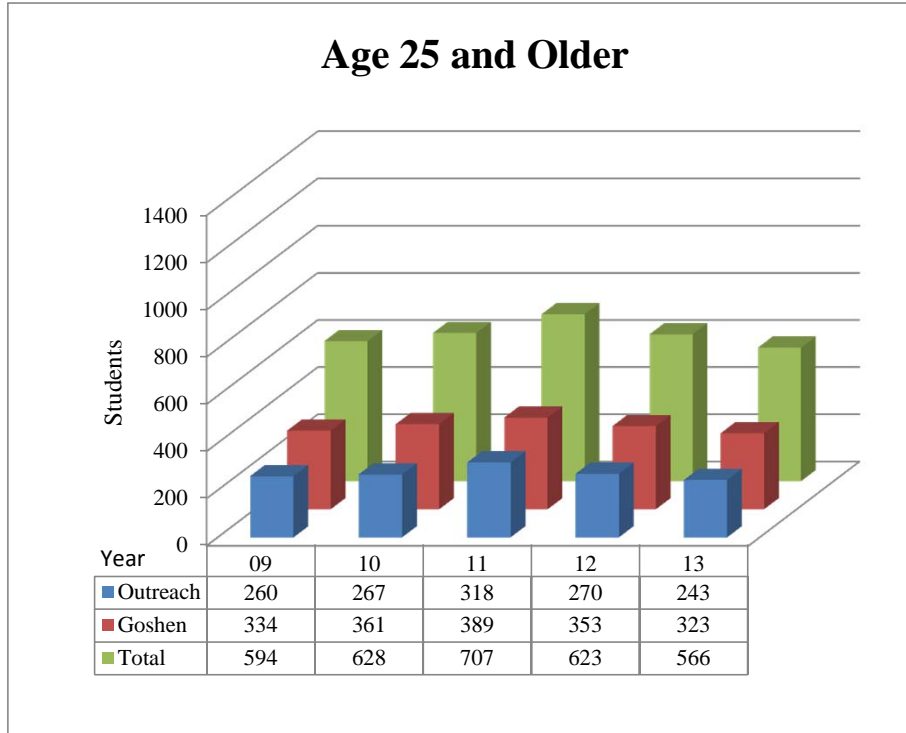
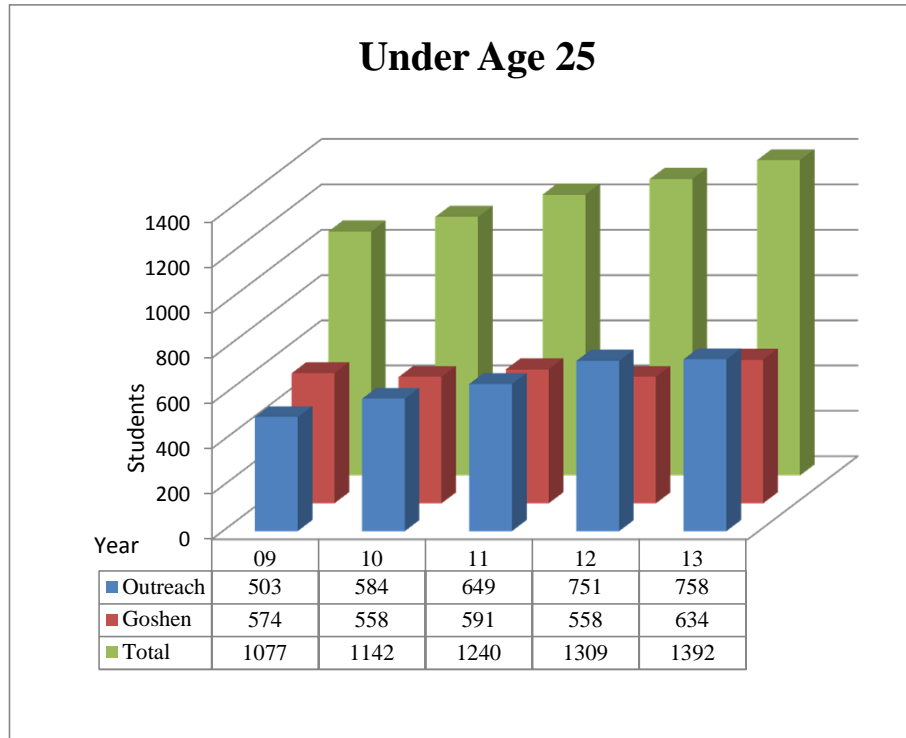

FALL AGE UNDER 25/AGE 25 AND OLDER



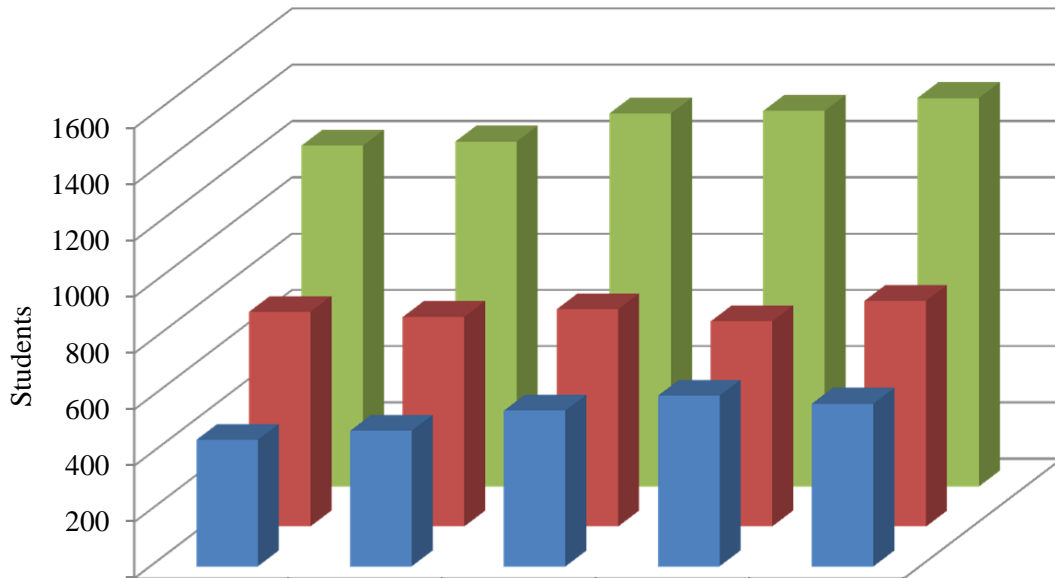
FALL FTE BY LOCATION

EWC experienced an increase of 45.20 (3.4%) FTE compared to Fall 2012. Outreach had a decrease of 28.05 (4.6%). Goshen County had an increase of 73.25 (10.0%) FTE. **The total FTE distribution was 41.9% Outreach and 58.1% Goshen County.** Goshen County FTE was above the five-year average 40.15. Outreach was above the five-year average 44.41. The total FTE is 84.56 above the five-year average.

FALL FTE BY STUDENT LOCATION

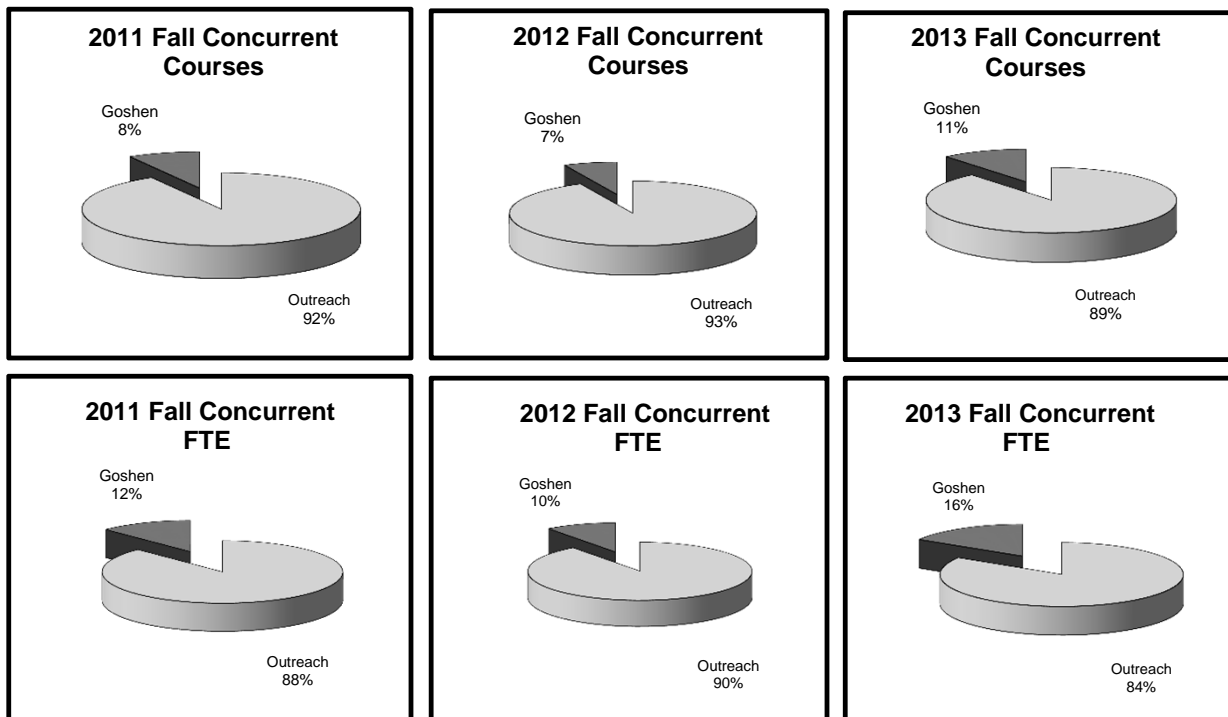

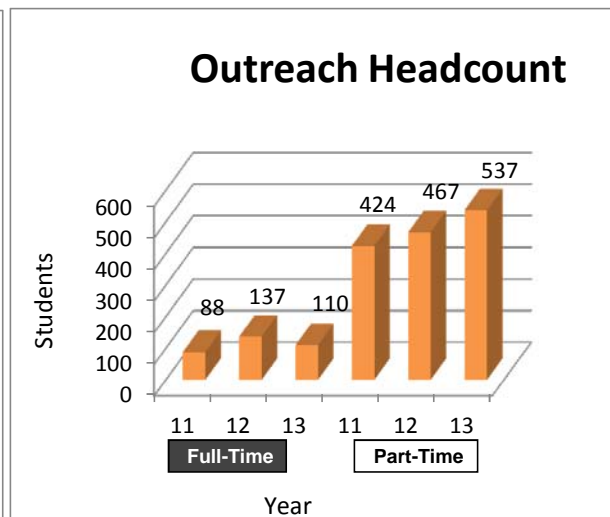
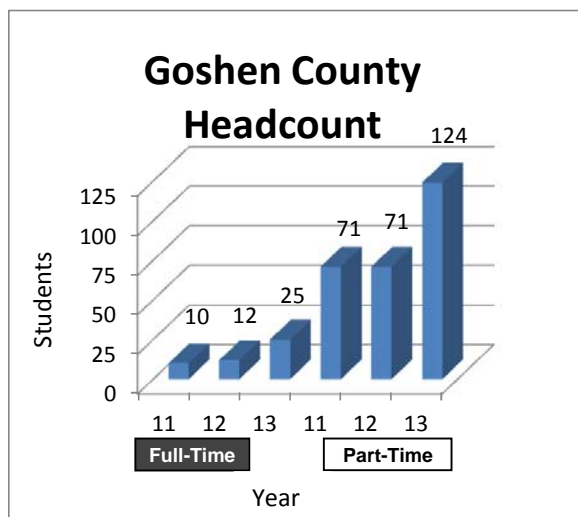


FALL HIGH SCHOOL STUDENT HEADCOUNT
